IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

AN ACT Relating to Fishing in Bog Brook, in Minot and Mechanic Falls.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Fishing in Bog Brook regulated. The commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting any person to fish for, take, catch or kill pickerel at any time on or through the ice in the waters of Bog Brook, in the towns of Minot and Mechanic Falls, in the county of Androscoggin, from Buckman's Bridge, so-called, to the Little Androscoggin River.
