AN ACT Closing Middle Range Pond to Ice Fishing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Ice fishing in Middle Range Pond. The commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulations forbidding any person to fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time on or through the ice in the waters of Middle Range Pond, said Pond being situated in the town of Poland, in the county of Androscoggin, or any person to have in possession at any time any kind of fish taken in violation of this rule and regulation.
