STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Closed Season on Foxes in Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 38, § 72, ¶ 1, amended. Paragraph I of section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

'Except that it shall be lawful to hunt or trap foxes in the county of Franklin from the 1st day of November to the 15th day of the following February.'
