AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Fur Bearing Animals.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S. c. 38, § 72, amended.** Section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subdivision:

'Provided further that in Lincoln county trapping for fox shall be lawful during the month of December and hunting for fox shall be lawful during the months of December, January and February, and the training of fox hounds, when properly collared shall be allowed from September 15th to December 1st.'
