IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

JOINT ORDER RELATIVE TO Investigation of Poultry Dept. of Highmoor Farm.

Ordered, The Senate concurring, that a committee of two be appointed on the part of the House with such as the Senate may join to investigate the operation of the poultry department at Highmoor Farm with especial reference to the question of its efficiency or inefficiency, and report to this Legislature during its regular session.

The members of said Committee shall have authority to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of books and records, and the Chairman is hereby authorized to administer oaths to witnesses.

The members of said Committee shall be reimbursed for all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with said investigation, to be paid out of legislative funds not to exceed the sum of \$100.00.
