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AN ACT Relating to Commitments in Bastardy Cases.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S. c. 111, § 3, amended.** Section 3, of chapter 111, of the revised statutes is hereby amended, by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘in the event the accused has been adjudicated or adjudged non compos mentis or insane previous to the date of said accusation and examination on oath, and a guardian for said accused has been appointed by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the accused shall not be apprehended on the above mentioned warrant but the legal guardian of the accused may be required to give bond to the complainant, with sufficient sureties.’
