AN ACT To Amend the Charter of the City of Hallowell.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 17, amended. Section 17 of said charter to be amended to read as follows:

‘The mayor, two aldermen, city marshal and street commissioner shall be elected from the citizens at large by the inhabitants of the city, voting in their respective wards; one alderman shall be elected by each ward being residents in the wards where elected; all said officers shall be elected by ballot, by a plurality of the votes given.

‘The city marshal and street commissioner shall hold their offices for a term of two years, or at the pleasure of the city council, and until others shall be appointed or elected and qualified in their places.’

Section 19, amended. Section 19 of said charter to be amended as follows: in section 19, line 44, after the words “said officer” insert the following clause: ‘**Except that for vacancies in the offices of city marshal or street commissioner, the mayor or acting mayor shall appoint a city marshal or street commissioner to fill the unexpired term, subject to removal by the appointing official.**’

Sec. 19 of said charter, being the same section, beginning with line 47, to be amended as follows: by striking out the words "and the Mayor or acting Mayor shall appoint a City Marshal or Street Commissioner to act until such election can be held."
