STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for the Establishment of a State Experimental Fur Farm.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

State experimental fur farm provided for. The commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby authorized to locate and establish, in connection with the state game farm, a state experimental fur farm, funds for this purpose to be taken from the appropriation for the maintenance of the department of inland fisheries and game when in the judgment of the commissioner and advisory council such funds are available.
