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AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicle Lights.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S. c. 29, § 82, amended.** The fifth paragraph of section 82 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Every motor vehicle of ~~seven~~  $6\frac{1}{2}$  feet or over in width shall have thereon at the extreme left **and right** on the body, one ~~amber~~ **red or green** lamp visible for a distance of at least 200 feet ahead of such vehicle **and the same on each side of the rear**. Motor vehicles requiring a light hereunder may, in lieu of such light, be equipped with an adequate reflector conforming as to color and marginal location to the requirements for such light **of not less than 4 inches in diameter.**'
