AN ACT Relating to Definitions Under Fish and Game Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 38, § 18. Section 18 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

‘For the purposes of this chapter the terms landlocked salmon and salmon shall be construed to mean the same.

‘For the purpose of this chapter all thoroughfares and bogs shall be under the same general laws as applies to lakes and ponds, except as hereinafter provided.’
