RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Day Mountain Pond.

Fishing in Day Mountain pond. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to close Day Mountain Pond, in the town of Strong, Franklin county, except to fly fishing with a daily limit of 15 fish of not less than 7 inches in length per person, under the rules and regulations of the department.
