RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing in Tacoma Lakes.

Ice fishing in Tacoma lakes regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Tacoma Lakes in Litchfield, Kennebec county, to ice fishing for white perch and pickerel only, on Mondays and Thursdays of each week between January 15 and March 15, both days inclusive.
