STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the South Portland Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Private laws of 1895, c. 242, item VIII, amended. Item VIII of chapter 242 of the private laws of 1895 as amended by chapter 37 of the private laws of 1925 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

Item VIII. Salary of judge. The judge of said court shall receive a salary of \$800 per year from the 1st day of January, 1925, to be paid him in quarterly payments from the county treasury of Cumberland county which shall be in full for the services as such judge. All blanks, civil and criminal, dockets and record books, required by said court, shall be furnished by the county of Cumberland.

Said judge shall have authority to appoint some suitable person to act as clerk of said court whose duty it shall be to prepare and keep the records of said court and perform such other duties as the judge of said court may direct and who shall receive a salary of \$300 each year to be paid in quarterly payments from the county treasury of Cumberland county which shall be in full for services as such clerk.
