IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to Fur-bearing Animals and Game Birds in
Cumberland County.

Hunting in Cumberland county, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby authorized to issue a rule and regulation making a closed season in the county of Cumberland on all fur-bearing animals, except muskrats, and on all game birds, from February 15 to October 31, both days inclusive.
