AN ACT Relative to Speed of Passenger Busses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 29, § 69, amended. Section 69 of chapter 29 of revised statutes is hereby amended by adding the following at the end of paragraph 6 of sub-division (b) of said section:

'No person shall drive or operate a passenger bus having a seating capacity of more than 7 passengers at a rate of speed in excess of 45 miles per hour.

This section shall not be construed to authorize the operation of any such bus at a speed in excess of that lawful for other vehicles under like circumstances.'

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
