STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relative to the Proof and Determination of Foreign Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 96, § 132, amended. Section 132 of chapter 96 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:

'Reference to the citation of such cases shall be deemed to incorporate them in the record. The determination of such law shall be for the court on all the evidence.'
