AN ACT Relating to Bounty on Bears.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 38, § 79, 2nd paragraph, amended. The 2nd paragraph of § 79 of c. 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Bounty on bears decreased. A bounty of ~~twenty-five~~ \$15 for each and every bear killed in said towns or plantations shall be paid to persons killing the same. These bounties shall be paid by the treasurer of said towns or plantations.'
