STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Provide a Penalty for Circulating False Reports Concerning Banks, Loan and Building Associations and Insurance Companies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 40 of the public laws of 1931 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Circulating false reports concerning banks, loan and building associations and insurance companies; penalty. Whoever maliciously makes, publishes, utters, repeats, or circulates any false report concerning any savings bank, national bank, trust company, or loan and building association or insurance company shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of not more than \$1000 or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.'
