STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

AN ACT to Provide Free Tuition at the University of Maine for Citizens
of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Tuition charges for citizens at U. of M. Citizens of the state of Maine attending the university of Maine shall not be required to pay the tuition charges.
