AN ACT Relating to Passing Another Vehicle.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S. c. 29, § 71, amended.** Section 71 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**'Sec. 71. Passing on a hill or curve, regulated.** No operator or driver of a vehicle shall overtake and pass another vehicle on a hill or curve where a free and unobstructed view of the highway ahead may not be had for a sufficient distance to insure such passing with safety.'
