AN ACT Relating to Eligibility of Members of City Governments to  
Certain Offices.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Members of city governments ineligible for certain offices.** No member of the board of aldermen, or council of any city having a population of over 40,000 inhabitants, shall during the term for which he was chosen, or within a period of 2 years next succeeding the termination of his term of office, be eligible for any other office, the salary of which is payable by the city; nor shall he during such term, or such period, hold any such office.
