AN ACT Relating to Tax on Radios.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Tax on radios, how assessed. City and town clerks shall assess the tax on radios according to their value ; 10 per cent of their value to be deducted each year for 5 years, after which time the assessment shall remain the same as the 5th year.
