AN ACT Repealing the Law Relating to Auxiliary State Forests.

Emergency Preamble. Whereas, The income of many of the towns of the state from tax receipts is decreasing to such an extent as to render the towns unable to meet their obligations, and

Whereas certain laws now in effect deprive the towns of a large amount of their taxable property, and

Whereas it is necessary in order that the financial condition of the towns may be safeguarded, and

Whereas in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section 16 of article XXXI of the Constitution of Maine and requires the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety,

Therefore

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Section 1. R. S. c. 11, §§ 82-89, repealed. Sections 82 to 89, inclusive, of chapter 11 of the revised statutes, and acts amendatory thereof, are hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. Emergency clause. In view of the emergency recited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
