AN ACT to Regulate the Speed of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Speed of motor vehicles regulated. Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 52 and 69 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, the state highway commission shall have authority to restrict the speeds of either commercial or pleasure vehicles at any and all points on the highway where in the opinion of the commission a rate of speed less than that now authorized by law will minimize the danger of accident and in each such place shall have authority to fix the rate of speed in accordance with its own judgment and place all necessary signs to give notice thereof.
