AN ACT Relating to Support of Persons Falling into Distress.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Authority of department of health and welfare as to support of persons in certain cases. Whenever it becomes known to the department of health and welfare that the overseers of the poor of any city or town are not making proper provision for the support of persons falling into distress in said city or town, the department shall have authority to provide said persons with such support as it may deem necessary and charge the expense of same to said city or town.
