IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

AN ACT Relating to Support of Dependent Persons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Dependent persons supported at the public expense shall not be considered paupers. No dependent person supported or assisted at the public expense shall be considered a pauper.
