IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

AN ACT to Require the Payment of a License Fee from Certain Peddlers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows

Peddlers to pay license fee; the users of. Every vehicle used for the purpose of peddling manufactured goods within the limits of the state shall pay a license fee of \$5.00 per year to the secretary of state, who shall issue appropriate plate or tag to be attached to such vehicle in a conspicuous place. The foregoing license fee shall be additional to the registration fee of any motor vehicle if such motor vehicle is used for the purpose of peddling such goods.
