IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

AN ACT Relating to Registration of Motor Vehicles for Use on Islands.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 29 of the revised statutes, amended. Chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after section 67 three new sections to be numbered 67A, 67B, and 67C.

'Sec. 67A. Registration of motor vehicles for use on islands. The secretary of state shall issue registration at one-half the fees otherwise provided in this chapter for motor vehicles to be operated from May 1st to November 1st on islands not connected with the mainland and containing not over ten miles of public highways, which registration shall not be valid other than on such islands.

'Sec. 67B. Application and registration forms. The application and registration forms shall be the same as otherwise provided except that they shall designate the purpose for which the motor vehicle is to be used as provided in the previous section.

'Sec. 67C. Plates. The secretary of state shall issue special plates for the purpose provided in the 2 preceding sections.'
