STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Stationary Vehicles Obstructing Way.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 29, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 4. Animal drawn vehicles regulated. No person shall leave his vehicle stationary in a way so as to obstruct the free passage of other vehicles or allow an animal drawn team to be in the way unattended unless it is reasonably fastened.'
