AN ACT Relating to the Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 17, relating to accounting of funds, amended. Chapter 17 the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting in said chapter after section 45-A a new section to be numbered 46, and to read as follows:

'Sec. 45-A. Accounting of appropriations and funds. All money and funds appropriated for, belonging to or credited for account of said Penobscot tribe of Indians shall be kept in separate accounts and not combined with the accounts or credits of any other tribe of Indians, or of any other department of the state.'
