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AN ACT Relating to Pauper Residence Disputes.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**State to investigate pauper residence claims.** The department of health and welfare shall investigate all cases, where pauper residence is concerned, that are reported to it by any town official. It shall keep a record of its investigations, and ascertain, to the best of its ability, what town, state or country the pauper concerned is a pauper resident of, and enter the facts upon the record. It shall notify the town, reporting, of the facts discovered ; and in case another town is found to be the legal pauper residence of the pauper, it shall notify the town officials of that town.
