AN ACT Relating to Stamping of Registered Boilers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S. c. 54, § 52, amended. Section 52 of chapter 54 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding an extra paragraph at the end of the first paragraph in said section as follows:—'After a steam boiler has been registered in the department of labor and industry, said department shall furnish, and the owner or user shall stamp, or have stamped, a number as given, on the shell of the boiler in the space commonly used for such purposes, with letters and figures not less than three-eighths of an inch high. Any person, firm or corporation obliterating or covering such number shall be punished by a fine of \$100.'
