IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

---

AN ACT to Prohibit the Baiting of Wild Ducks in Hancock County.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Section 56 of chapter 38 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following :

'No person shall unlawfully and with intent to bait ducks deposit any food or substance intended to advance bait wild ducks. This prohibition shall apply only to waters in Hancock county.'
