RESOLVE, Relating to Ice Fishing in Webber Pond and Three Mile Pond.

---

**Resolved:** That there shall be an open season for ice fishing on Friday, Saturday and Sunday of each week under the provisions of the general law, in the waters of Webber Pond, in the town of Vassalboro, and in the waters of Three Mile Pond, in the towns of China, Windsor and Vassalboro, in the county of Kennebec.
