S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to County Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S. c. 125, § 43, last paragraph, amended. The last paragraph of § 43 of c. 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘Compensation for travel between place of abode and county seat. Said salaries shall be in full for all services and expenses ~~and travel~~, including the management of the jails and work shops and the sale of their products, except that each county commissioner shall be allowed five cents per mile for the distance actually traveled from his place of abode to the county seat to and from each regular and adjourned session of their board; excepting also actual necessary cash expenses incurred outside of their respective counties for the transaction of official business; and expenses incurred at public hearings away from the county seat; all bills for such expenses shall be approved by the clerk of courts and the county attorney of their county; excepting also, such expenses as are provided for in section twenty-six of chapter ninety-two.’
