AN ACT Permitting Towns to Contract for Road Work.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Notwithstanding any provisions of law, towns and cities are hereby authorized and empowered to let on contract to one or more persons, firms or corporations, all road work that the town or city may undertake (including snow removal, building, repair and maintenance of roads). All persons, firms or corporations so contracting with the town shall furnish a bond in a bonding company duly authorized to do business in the state of Maine conditioned on the faithful performance of the work.
