STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Itinerant Vendors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 46, amended. Chapter 46 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting therein a new section, to be numbered 14-A, and to read as follows:

'Sec. 14-A. Any retailer offering merchandise for sale by sample either from out of or within the state shall pay to the clerk of the city or town in which such exhibit is made a fee of \$75 or such sum as the municipal officers may determine not to exceed \$75 for each day or part of a day that such display shall be maintained. This fee shall be in lieu of any tax on the amount of sales made by such itinerant vendor.'
