RESOLVE, Opening Jaquith Pond, in Brownville, to Ice Fishing.

Jaquith Pond opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to open Jaquith Pond, in the town of Brownville, to ice fishing under the general law by an appropriate rule and regulation.
