AN ACT to Amend An Act to Incorporate the Guilford and Sangerville
Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 16 of chapter 201 of the private and special laws of 1911, as amended by section 10 of chapter 81 of the private and special laws of 1929, as further amended by section 2 of chapter 82 of the private and special laws of 1931, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 16. Acquisition of properties necessary to make act valid. If said water district shall fail to acquire the plant, properties, franchises, rights and privileges owned by said Guilford Water Company and Sangerville Water Supply Company, aforesaid, by purchase, or to file its petition to take the same by the exercise of the right of eminent domain as hereinbefore provided, in either case before the 1st day of July, ~~1933~~, 1936, this act shall become null and void. Said district shall not begin to furnish water under this act until it shall have acquired the properties of said Guilford Water Company and Sangerville Water Supply Company, as hereinbefore provided.'
