STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Procuring Testimonials for the Purpose of Marking the Unmarked Graves of the Soldiers of the Revolutionary War.

Marking of graves of soldiers of the Revolutionary War; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$150 be and hereby is appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1934, for the purpose of procuring testimonials to be used in marking the unmarked graves of the soldiers of the Revolutionary War.

Resolved further: That with the approval of the governor and council, said sum shall be paid into the treasury of the "Sons of the American Revolution", with which they are hereby authorized to procure and distribute such number of markers as may, from time to time, be required for the purposes herein specified.
