STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Lawrence Hahn.

Lawrence Hahn compensated for damage done by an escaped convict. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$46.17 to be paid to Lawrence Hahn, of Thomaston, to compensate him for the damage caused to his automobile by escaped convicts from the state prison, to be paid from the funds appropriated for the state prison.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Convicts escaped from the state prison and stole the car of Lawrence Hahn from his garage, and used it to escape to Woburn, Mass., where the car was recovered. This claim is for the expenses caused.
