RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Oscar Lund of East Machias.

---

**Pension provided for Oscar Lund. Resolved:** That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Oscar Lund, of East Machias, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Oscar Lund is the son of George Lund who enlisted March 24, 1864, and was mustered out April 9, 1864. He is about 40 years of age and has been a cripple since birth. He is mentally and physically unable to provide for himself and his support is a hardship upon his relatives.
