#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Kennebec Journal Company for Printing Public Laws of the State of Maine.

Kennebec Journal Company compensated. Resolved: That the sum of \$70 be and hereby is appropriated to be paid the Kennebec Journal Company of Augusta, Maine, for publishing and circulating the public laws passed by the legislature of 1931 in the Boothbay Register and the Lubec Herald, to be paid from the general funds of the state.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The sum of \$70 is due the Kennebec Journal for publishing and circulating the public laws of 1931, but as they were late in getting in their bills the total appropriation for this purpose had been expended and there were no funds to pay the bills. The Secretary of State has approved both these bills.
