STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Fred E. Stevens of Chelsea.

Pension provided for Fred E. Stevens. Resolved: That a pension of \$15 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Fred E. Stevens, of Chelsea, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Fred E. Stevens is the son of David Stevens who served in the First Maine Cavalry and was honorably discharged August 1, 1864. His is 68 years of age, has rheumatism and two ruptures, and is unable to work. He was recently burned out and lost everything he had. He is badly in need of assistance.
