STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for George L. Harvey of
Belfast.

George L. Harvey, pension for. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to George L. Harvey, of Belfast, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

George L. Harvey is the son of Josiah Harvey who served in Co. K. 26th Reg. of Inf., Maine Vols., during the Civil War. He was mustered into service October 11, 1862, and discharged by order of the surgeon on December 2, 1862. George L. Harvey is now 73 years of age, unable to work, and dependent upon a grandson who in turn is helped by the town.
