STATE OFMAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating the Length of Trout in Lakes and Ponds in York County.

Trout fishing in lakes and ponds of York county, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting the catching, taking or killing of any trout less than 10 inches in length in any of the lakes or ponds of York county, or have in possession any such trout taken therefrom.
