STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

RESOLVE, to Regulate Fishing in Lone Pond in the Town of Waterboro
in the County of York.

Fishing in Lone Pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting all fishing in Lone Pond in the town of Waterboro in the county of York, except fly fishing in accordance with the special law regulating the open season for pickerel in York county, with a daily bag limit of not more than 5 fish in all in the waters of said pond.
