RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Melissa M. Bailey, of  
Portland.

---

**Melissa M. Bailey; state pension. Resolved:** That a pension of \$15 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Melissa M. Bailey of Portland, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Melissa M. Bailey is the daughter of David Bailey who served in Co. C, 17th Maine Regiment, during the Civil War; his service being from February 29, 1864, to September 11, 1865.

She is now 79 years of age, very feeble in health, and without means of support. For a number of years she has been cared for by private charity. She is a deserving person and entirely worthy of assistance by the state.
