STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relative to the Rules and Regulations on the Fishing for White Perch in Little River in the Towns of Old Orchard Beach and Scarboro in the Counties of York and Cumberland.

Fishing for white perch in Little river, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby authorized to issue a rule and regulation, prohibiting the taking of white perch in Little river in the towns of Old Orchard Beach and Scarboro in the counties of York and Cumberland, except that, they may be taken therefrom with single hook and line for consumption as food in the family of the person taking the same. Not more than 5 pounds of white perch shall be taken therefrom, or had in possession in any 1 day.
