RESOLVE, Restricting the Taking of Smelts in Panther Pond, in the
County of Cumberland.

Smelt fishing in Panther pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting the taking of smelts more than 6 inches in length by any means in Panther pond, in the county of Cumberland, or any of the tributaries of said pond; except such smelts may be taken in the day time with single hook and line in the ordinary manner.
